

Danube Delta - the paradise of birds

Danube River ends its long journey across Europe in Romania, embracing with three big arms the Black Sea, giving birth to a unique area known worldwide: **the Danube Delta.**

This area is one of Romania's UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Earning its listing due to being the largest and best-preserved of Europe's deltas, the Biosphere Reserve has the third largest biodiversity in the world, surpassed only by the Great Barrier Reef in Australia and the Galapagos Islands in Ecuador. With its water channels, fisherman houses and boats, great variety of plants and large population of birds, Danube Delta is a destination for those who want to explore the authentic part of Romania.
